Our Aim

SafeSpace's Homelessness Awareness and Prevention Interventions Team (HAPI Team) will work with you if you are homeless, if you think you are at risk of becoming homeless or if you feel that you are not safe in your home.

We can give you independent advice and support and let you know what your options are.

SafeSpace's Hapi Team are here to support you with your housing and homelessness issues. This will involve communicating with other services/agencies. Some of the ways in which they might support you are by; giving advice and guidance, referring/speaking to other agencies or accommodation projects, mediation with parents/carers, support and assistance with applying for/moving into accommodation, support with benefits and much more.

How the Project will work

- If you are 16/17 and you approach agencies with housing/homelessness issues, they will refer you to SafeSpace's Hapi Team. SafeSpace's HAPI Team will contact you on the same day where possible. They may be able to provide in depth support over the telephone or invite you to meet with them to provide face to face support.

- Remember that the SafeSpace HAPI Team want to hear about and support you with your housing and homelessness issues.

- SafeSpace's HAPI Team also hold a weekly drop in service for young people to pop in for advice and support with no appointment necessary.
